

Terms and Conditions – Rendezvous with a Chef

All proceeds will benefit The Great Food Drive for Children, a Moisson Montréal campaign in partnership with Moisson Rive-Sud and Moisson Estrie.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Individuals aged 18 and over; companies, organisations or other legal entities are all eligible to bid in the auctions.
2. The staff, management and directors of Moisson Montréal, Moisson Rive-Sud and Moisson Estrie are eligible to bid in the auctions. These bids are made in their personal capacity.

PARTICIPATION MODALITIES

1. Any person wishing to bid has to complete the online form and indicate, by checking the “I Accept” box, that they will respect the following regulations and will pay the bid for which they won the auction, if applicable.
2. Any person wishing to bid must be aware that the Montreal chefs offering a dinner at home will only travel within the Greater Montreal region, whereas in the case of Jean-Patrice Fournier only within the Estrie (Eastern Townships) region.
3. The auctions will open Monday April 16th, at 8:00 AM and close Monday April 23rd at 12:00 PM Eastern Time (on Moisson Montréal’s server).
4. The bids must be made by minimum increments of \$100.
5. There is no limit to the number of bids that one bidder can make. It is possible to make a higher bid. Each click equals one bid and bids cannot be cancelled. Moisson Montréal cannot void the bids of participants.
6. Moisson Montréal is not responsible for any malfunctions of its website during the auction period, including for problems or failures of online computer systems, unreceived emails due to a technical problem or congestion of the Internet or website or any combination of the aforementioned factors that may affect the participation of a person in this draw.

CONFIRMATION OF WINNERS AND PAYMENT PERIOD

1. At the closing of the auction, the highest registered bid for each one of the chefs will be the winners of the respective auctions.
2. The six respective highest bidding participants will be informed by e-mail in the minutes following the closure of the auction. They will be asked to communicate with Moisson Montréal to complete their payment by telephone. The winners will have until noon on April 26th 2018 to communicate with Moisson Montréal and to complete their payment.
3. In the case of a failure to respect the terms of the payment, Moisson Montreal reserves the right to offer each non-paid prize to the second-highest bidder.

4. If an auction winner is unable to communicate with Moisson Montreal in the said time period, they will have to obtain a delay authorization for their payment with Moisson Montreal by writing to elamoureux@moissonmontreal.org or calling 514 344-4494, ext. 238. Moisson Montréal reserves the right to refuse a delay request. Only exceptional circumstances and a written agreement to pay the winning could be acceptable to grant the delay.

COMMON PROVISIONS

PURCHASE CONFIRMATION AND NON-PAYMENT

1. Once the highest bidder will have transmitted the information needed for the payment to Moisson Montréal, they will receive an e-mail confirming the reception of the said information, details of the prize won and the amount of the prize. Moisson Montréal will be informed by its financial institution of the status of the transaction within 24 hours (business days) following the transmission of the information by the bidder.
2. If the transaction is declined, a member of the Moisson Montréal staff will contact the bidder to obtain the information necessary for the payment or to arrange a different payment method. In the case of non-payment, Moisson Montréal reserves the right to offer each unpaid prize to the second-highest bidder.

SALE CONDITIONS

1. The auction prize is neither exchangeable nor refundable. No compensation of any kind will be accorded.
2. Alcoholic beverages are not included in the dinner except for Eric Gonzalez and Jean-François Méthot. The winning bidders would have to arrange for their own alcoholic beverages for their supper.
3. Each chef remains solely responsible for the menu and dinner offered to the winner of his or her auction. Moisson Montréal shall not be held liable regarding the prize offered.

DELIVERY OF THE PRIZE

The date, time and place of the supper will be determined by the winners and the respective chefs by mutual agreement. It is understood that the supper will take place in a reasonable delay, within a year after the auction at the latest.

Eric Gonzalez: 7 course dinner (food and wine pairing) at l'Atelier de Joël Robuchon.

Jean-François Méthot: 5 course dinner (food and wine pairing) at the restaurant Coureur des Bois

RESPONSABILITY FOR THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE AUCTION

1. Moisson Montréal will do everything in its power to avoid interruptions in the proceedings of the auction, but offers no guarantees. Should an interruption occur, for technical reasons, or linked to material programs, software, internet connection or power failure, Moisson Montréal will take the necessary actions to bring the auction back online in the shortest delays for it to continue until the date and time scheduled for its closure, which is Monday April 23rd, 12:00PM Eastern Time.
2. Any message received by a bidder or showcased on the auction website announcing a winner before 12:00PM on April 23rd Eastern Time, will constitute an error of the computer system and will not be considered final by Moisson Montréal.
3. The bidders are responsible to follow relevant announcements online, in case of an error in the computer system or an interruption, to follow the proceedings of the auction until the closing on Monday April 23rd, 12h00 PM Eastern Time.
4. In case of force majeure, Moisson Montréal reserves the right to terminate the auction without any other formality, without adjudication and without liability for damages following said action.
5. In case of force majeure, the chefs reserve the right postpone the date of the activity. The new date would be communicated to the winner within a reasonable delay. Since the auction is a fundraising activity with the objective of raising money for buying and distributing food for children 0- 5 years old, no refund would be issued.
